St. Maximilian Kolbe Parish is pleased to be able to offer electronic fund transfer to our parishioners. It's the easy, convenient, and safe way to make your Offering or make payments to our Building Fund.

EFT is Easy . . .

With electronic funds transfer, you don't have to write and mail a check. You'll never have to scramble during Mass to make out a check as the basket is coming by. No more digging into your wallet or purse looking for cash.

Once a month, the amount you select will be deducted automatically from your checking or savings account. You don't have to do a thing except sign up.

EFT is Convenient . . .

Sign up by completing the EFT Authorization Form and return it to the Parish Office. If you want the funds deducted from your checking account, attach a check with "VOID" written across it. That's all there is to it! Deductions will start the following month.

EFT is Safe . . .

There are several safeguards built in to the program to make sure no one can withdraw anything from your account except what you have authorized. Plus, you can change the amount or cancel your participation at any time.

EFT Helps the Parish . . .

When people make a regular commitment of support, the parish can better plan its income and expenses. That's important for the financial stability of the parish.

EFT Encourages Good Stewardship . . .

Switching to EFT is a good time to examine your sharing with the Church. When we give a gift to another person, the more we love that person, the more care we take in selecting a gift that shows how we feel about that person. Our Church is God's gift to us; when we share our gifts with the Church, we are doing God's work. A gift that is rooted in prayer and is proportional to our means is one of the essential ways to show our thanks for all that God does for us.
