

Gardener Application Form

The Garden of Eaten Community Garden will open for its first year on May 15, 2016. Currently there are 8 garden plots (10' x 12') and 50 smaller plots (2' x 4') located in front of the rectory at St. Maximilian Kolbe parish in Scarborough. Seven of the plots are available to parishioners of St. Maximilian Kolbe, St. Bartholomew and St. John & Holy Cross. One plot will be designated to provide produce for the South Portland Food Cupboard and the Scarborough Food Pantry. Plots will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

Each gardener will be required to assist in maintaining the plot designated for the South Portland Food Cupboard and the Scarborough Food Pantry. In addition, gardeners will be expected to donate a portion of their crop to these organizations to help feed local families in need.

Fees and Assignment of Plots

\$5.00 for each 2' x 4' plot (Kiddie Plot) - Limit 3 per family

\$25.00 for each 10' x 12' plot (Family Plot) – Limit 1 per family

\$20.00 contribution toward extra loam and compost in the Spring and Fall (if needed)

We will be assigning plots on a first-come, first-served basis. Payment must be received with your application in order to be eligible for a plot. Please see the website for guidelines.
